ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for admission to a program leading to a DEP, students must meet one of the following criteria:

- Persons holding a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent (a comparative evaluation of your studies issued by the MICC or document recognized in Appendix 5 Chapter 6 of the guide to the certification of studies guide). The diploma or its equivalent must be in your file before the beginning of each course OR
- Persons holding a Secondary School Diploma or its recognized equivalent, for example, proof of equivalence of Secondary V studies, or postsecondary diploma (Diploma of College Studies or Bachelor's degree) OR
- Persons who are at least 16 years old age on September 30 of the school year in which their
 training is to begin and have earned the Secondary IV credits in language of instruction, second
 language and mathematics in the programs of study established by the Minister, or have been
 granted recognition of equivalent learning OR
- Persons who are at least 18 years old at the time of training and has functional prerequisites for successful completion of the General Development Test as well as specific prerequisites or recognition of equivalent learning OR
- Persons who have obtained Secondary III credits in language of instruction, second language and
 mathematics in programs established by the Minister are required to pursue his general education
 courses (concomitance), concurrently with his vocational training, in order to obtain the Secondary
 IV credits they lack in Language of Instruction, second language and mathematics.
